Kindred to donate exposure rights to EHF EUROS 2020

Kindred Group will donate all exposure rights during games played in Norway for Men's and Women's 2020 EHF EUROS. ENALMH, a network aiming to promote active living in order to prevent and address mental health problems will be the beneficiary of the rights.
